A Student may obtain to select as Major Course mentioned above which is subject to the selection and Head of the department concerned. The selection test will be conducted by the selection Committee of the respective department. And the process will be completed with the approval of the principal.

## COMBINATION OF SUBJECTS FOR GENERAL COURSE:

As per guideline of Gauhati University the combination of subjects for general course comprises of compulsory subjects with elective subject list from CBCS.



## A Summary of the GU UG- CBCS

### What is UG-CBCS?

The undergraduate degree (UG) programme in the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) will have courses spread across six-semesters of any undergraduate degree course. Two consecutive (one odd and one even) semesters will make up an academic year. An UG course shall be of Six Semesters covering three Calendar Years (Academic Session- June to May). The duration of the Odd Semesters (First, Third, and Fifth) shall be June-November, and that of Even Semesters (Second, Forth and Sixth) shall be December - May.

### How does it work?

The courses in GU UG-CBCS are categorised primarily into three types of courses - Core, Elective, and Ability/Skill Enhancement courses. At the core elective courses will comprise of six(6) credits and skill courses are of four (4) credits.

### Core Course:

As the name suggests, a core course is a necessary course that a student MUST take in order to complete the degree. The number of core courses for Honours and Regular degrees are different.

### Elective Course:

An elective course is the one for which a student has some kind of freedom to choose from a pool of courses. There are two kinds of elective courses- Generic and Discipline Specific. The generic elective courses are those, which can be chosen by a student belonging to any stream, while the discipline specific elective courses are particular to only the discipline concerned. However, a student pursuing an honours degree course can choose a generic elective from any other discipline except from the honours course itself.

### Ability/ Skill Enhancement Course:

An ability or skill Enhancement course is aimed at providing the student will skill and ability. These courses have four (4) credits each in contrast to the core or elective courses. The ability enhancement courses MUST be opted by a student and the student can choose papers from a pool of skill enhancement courses.

### Dissertation/ Project:

A student can opt. (subject to conditions) a dissertation or a project work in lieu a 6-credit discipline specific elective course in the sixth semester.

### The Nation of Credit:

A student needs to earn a required number of credits in order to successfully complete a degree. The credit is closely related is closely related to the number of stipulated classes a student has to complete. The following table indicates the number of credit a student can earn for each type of indicated classes.

## REGULATION OF TDC/ B.A. FOR SEMESTER SYSTEM

(1) TDC/ B.A. shall be of Six semesters covering three calendar year. The Schedule for semester system is shown as below:

2. Students Performance should be monitored through the semester by continuous assesment in the theory and practical courses. Evaluation of the students performance in each of the theory and practical paper will be based on the following :

Internal Evaluation : 10/15/20/25 marks.

External Evaluation : 40/ 60/ 75/ 80 marks.

3. Internal Evaluation should be based on one sectional examination, Project report preparation, Home assignments, Seminars and library works in each semester.

4. External evaluation should be through a final examination at the end of the semester.

5. The pass marks in each theory paper is 30% and in each practical paper is 40%.

6. In each paper, students must secure pass marks in both the internal as well as the external evaluation seperately.

7. Students who could not appear or failed in any semester examination will be allowed to clear the same as below:

- (a) First semester with the regular third semester examination .
- (b) Second semester with the regular fourth semester examination.
- (c) Third semester with the regular fifth semester examination.
- (d) Fourth semester with the regular sixth semester examination.

8. A student may allowed to "repeat" on any one of the theory papers in the first, second, third and fourth semester and may be allowed for "betterment" of marks in one paper in the fifth semester provided that the student secures less than 45% marks in the paper.

9. No "repeat"/ "betterment" shall be allowed to the practical examinations in any semester.

10. A student must pass all his examinations, including "repeat" and "betterment" chances within five years from the date of admission to the first semester course. A student will get a maximum of three chances to clear a particular semester.

11. In case of any dispute regarding evaluation or unforeseen events the matter may be placed in the appropriate committee of the University for amicable settlement.

12. Since the semester system involves continuous assesment there would be no scope for a student to appear as a private candidate in any subject.

13. For any matter not covered under these regulations for semester system, the existing University rules and the Gauhati University Act 1949. (as amended till date) should be applicable.



## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- (1) Eligibility : Students who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10 +2) level or any other equivalent examination in their respective streams conducted by the Board, Council or University recognised by Universities are eligible to undertake the degree courses.
- (2) Application for seeking admission to the college should be apply in the prescribed admission form. Students may obtain prospectus along with admission form, academic calendar and progress report of the students from college office on cash payment of Rs. 200/- only on all working days.
- (3) Students are required to fill the relevent columns carefully and enclose all attested copies of relevent testimonials while submitting the forms to the college office on or before the stipulated date. Incomplete and delayed submission of application form will be summarily rejected without intimation to the concern students.
- (4) Every student must plant a sapling with protection in the college campus and a photograph of the same with the candidate is to be attached with the admission form is mandatory.
- (5) Selection of candidates for admission is done by an admission board constituted by the principal of the college. The board prepares the list of the selected candidates and displays it on the college notice board well ahead of the admission dates. The selected candidates are required to get themselves admission on the dates as notified by producing the following documents in original.
  - (i) Mark sheet of the qualifying examination.
  - (ii) H.S.L.C. Admit card.
  - (iii) Certificate from the Head of the institution last attended.
  - (iv) Gap certificate if necessary (for students passing the qualifying examinations earlier than the current year.)
  - (v) Caste certificate for SC/ST/OBC/ MOBC candidates. Provisional Certificate will not be accepted.
  - (vi) Certificate of proficiency in co-curricular or extra curicular activities (if and where necessary)
6. Seats are limited.
7. Reservation of seats is as per rule.
8. Selection for Major subject is subject to the approval of HoD concerned. Entrance test is conducted.
9. All admissions are provisional and subject to the approval of G.U.
10. A candidate is permitted to seek admission only for one programme in a given academic session.
11. The college authority decides all other matters not covered by the above clauses relating to admission and selection.
12. Violation of the rule results in cancellation of admission and forfeiture of admission fees.
13. Notices regarding admission are displayed on the college Notice Board in due course.

## EVALUATION SYSTEM

To develop a process of continuous evaluation of students achievement as teaching progress and make evaluation as an integral part of teaching learning process. Luitparia college evaluates the performance of students through sessional tests. For the smooth conduct of all the internal examinations of the college an examination board is constituted with a convener and the other members are appointed from time to time by the principal.

Various types of activities such as seminar, filed work, educational tour, etc. would be compulsory for the students.



## **ATTENDANCE**

1. Attendance to classes is compulsory.
2. Students shall not be eligible to appear at the University Examination as regular candidate if he/she has not attended minimum of 75% lectures delivered in each subject separately.
3. Students attaining less than 75% lectures will be treated as irregular or non collegiate and such student will have to pay a sum of Rs. 300/-

## **GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

The following rules and regulations are to be strictly followed by the students-

- (A) Attendance in class is compulsory. Each student is required to attend a minimum of 75% classes held in one academic session, failing which the College shall have the right to take necessary action.
- (B) A student must not abstain from attending SEMINARS & other functions in the College.
- (C) A student must carry the identity card issued by the College authority in the College premises and must produce it if and when necessary. He/She must surrender the identity card at the time of receiving pass/transfer certificate.
- (D) Use the language, ungentlemanly conduct, ragging in any form, teasing, showing disregard to the teachers and office staff, violation of the examination rules, damage to College property, will definitely invite stern disciplinary action.
- (E) Consumption of alcohol, tobacco; smoking cigarette in the College campus, loitering in front of the classrooms or in the corridors are strictly forbidden.
- (F) No society or organization can be formed in the College nor shall any person be invited to address a meeting in the College premises without the prior permission of the College authority or the Principal of the College.
- (G) Students shall have their bicycles, scooters or motorcycles locked in the newly built parking shade located in the college campus area at their own risk.
- (H) Students should see the Notice Board regularly.
- (I) All powers for maintenance of discipline are vested with the Principal of the College. The College tries its best to maintain peace and harmony among the students and wants each and every student to uphold and preserve this tradition.

## **FACILITIES AVAILABLE IN THE COLLEGE :**

### **The College Library:**

The college library is situated within the academic campus of the college. There are more than 12728 volumes covering all subjects including books of general knowledge and references. In addition, there are more than 10 journals and e-book facilities. The library provides spacious reading room for students and teachers. The library opens in all working days from 9AM to 4 PM. The college library rules are framed in keeping with University library rules. The books are catalogued as DDC system. The college has made considerable improvements in library facilities for readers.

### **Rules for library :**

- (a) The college library is for the use of both students and teachers.
- (b) Students may borrow two books at a time.
- (c) Students are issued library cards and return the borrowed book on or before 15 days from the date of Issue.
- (d) If a student requires the book for more than the aforesaid period he/ she shall have to renew the book from the library, otherwise a fine is imposed upon the defaulting students.
- (v) Students should maintain silence in the library cum reading room.



## The College Magazine

The college issues its magazine every year and it comprises of three sections, viz- English, Assamese and Hindi. It includes contribution from the students and the staff members. In addition, a central wall magazine as well as departmental wall magazines published periodically encourage the students for literary achievements and exposure.

## Students Union

Luitparia College Students Union is constituted annually as per rules provided in the constitution of the Union. The union plays an important role in the college by organising different students' activities, competitions, functions and festival in co-operation with the college authority. The membership to the Union is compulsory for all students.

## INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC)

The National Policy on Education (NPE) and the Programme Of Action (POA), 1986 inter alia recommended that "Excellence of Institutions of Higher Education is a function of many aspects: Self evaluation and self-improvement are important. If a mechanism is set up which will encourage self-assessment in institutions and assessment and accreditation by a council .....The quality process, participation, achievement etc. will be constantly monitored and improved."

In pursuance of the above University Grants Commission (UGC) u/s 12 ccc of the UGC Act 1956 (3) established the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) of 16th September, 1994 at Bangaluru (Bangalore). This concerns among academics for ensuring quality in higher education has been a source of strength and inspiration for NAAC.

Therefore, it is imperative that HEIs must have their own internal mechanism for Sustenance, Assurance and Enhancement of quality culture of education imparted by them.

In pursuance of the above and also notified by the affiliating authority (UGC and University) an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Luitparia college, Alopai Majar Char has been formed in the year 2014. There is a core committee of IQAC. For any assessment and subsequent accreditation is made with reference to a set of parameters, so that the standard of an institution can be compared with that of other similar institutions.
